

On behalf of Aerospace New Zealand, we also invite you to attend the New Zealand Aerospace Summit in Christchurch as part of your tour.



Qantas Sydney (SYD) Queenstown (ZQN) 15:10 – 21:15


Pick up a rental car to your chosen accommodation

Option 2: Queenstown Adventure





Wind up your adrenaline by bungy jumping, jet boating or white water rafting. You can drive to Invercargill tomorrow!




Evening options
